Subject: We're Making and Epic Move: Introducing Rover, Haiku and Canto

Rover, Haiku, and Canto are the applications that make up Epic's mobile platform and provide end-to-end solutions for both clinical and communication workflows. When using the apps, clinicians can access patient information, document in the medical record, communicate with the patient care team, and respond to clinical alarms. **These applications will replace Mobile Heartbeat after Epic goes live on January 31, 2020.**

Haiku (for iPhone use) and Canto (for iPad use) are the mobile apps for physicians, housestaff, and advanced practice practitioners. All other Epic users will use Rover.

Physicians, advanced practice practitioners, residents and fellows, nurses, peri-op staff, and a subset of other groups in operations will receive an iPhone for use with Epic. If you haven't already received a phone, IT will be distributing them in early January. Employees who are eligible can pick up their iPhones at local Tech Stops starting on DATE between the hours of 8 a.m.-11 p.m., Monday - Friday. IT will also go to the units to capture those unable to make it to Tech Stop.
