In September, [high level benefits of Epic](#) were introduced. This month, more detailed information on some of those benefits are included below:

Having a **single record for inpatient and outpatient visits** will improve the continuity and quality of care by sharing information between the inpatient and outpatient setting, avoiding duplicate testing, and enhancing communication among providers. The unified patient portal, Connect, will also improve communication between providers and patients.

Previously, you heard about **Care Everywhere**, the system that allows practitioners at NYP to securely access patient records from other facilities. Data sharing through Care Everywhere results in the same benefits for our providers and our patients.

When Epic goes live, **advanced dictation tools** will be available to use with the system. A cloud-based medical speech recognition solution will help physicians create higher quality documentation. Epic offers a number of additional ways to document including note templates and SmartPhrases, all to save providers time.

What will Epic look like?
