What is happening?

Specialists Training Specialists (STS) recruitment for Epic Go-Live 4 is ongoing until July 16. STSs are providers from each specialty who help facilitate training.

Super User recruitment opens on July 12 and ends on August 6, 2021. A Super User provides operational support for the Epic implementation. Super Users will answer end user questions, and assist end users at the elbow during Go-Live. They will attend training and be engaged from November 2021 to December 2021, see below for registration and more information. Staff must speak with their manager first if interested.
